ACADEMICS

- The Curriculum Assessment Policy Statement (CAPS) is implemented. The LOLT is English. English is the only home language offered until Grade 9.
- Grade 12 students write the IEB Senior Certificate Examination. Domino Servite has achieved 100% Matric pass rate since its registration as an examination centre in 1988.
- Our learners are registered to participate in the IEB Core Skills Test and the ACER International Benchmarking Test to ensure comparable global standards.
- Our learners participate in many Olympiads and various external co-curricular competitions.
- Homework is given to reinforce what has been done in the classroom and to encourage independent research and study habits.
- Intervention strategies are developed to assist learners who experience barriers to learning.

Domino Servite has design, art and computer centres, a library and laboratories for the sciences.
